Newsletter: Prepared quarterly now, it will include a summary of news, events, contact info for the board members and other items of interest. Will be sent via e-mail and posted on the website, Facebook, and Scubaboard (see below).

Group e-mail: Will use this to send out announcements for items that come up between newsletter editions. This will supplement what is on the main website.
