DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO EXTEND SELF-SURRENDER DATE

COMES NOW, Defendant, PETER SOTIS, by and through the undersigned counsel, and submits this Motion to Extend Self- Surrender Date, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. On January 12, 2022, the Defendant was sentenced to fifty-seven months.
2. Defendant Sotis is to report to the Bureau of Prisons on Monday, March 14, 2022 by 2:00 p.m. (DE 156).
3. On March 10, 2012, the United States Probation Department notified Defendant Sotis that he had been designated to the minimum-security camp at FCI Coleman.
4. Defendant Sotis recently had a blood test that “revealed an increased PSA level from his baseline concerning for prostate cancer. This will need immediate evaluation that cannot be delayed.” (*See* Exhibit 1 attached).
5. Defendant Sotis requests an additional sixty days before he is required to self-surrender so that he may complete various medical diagnostic tests as recommended by his physician, and also begin a treatment plan, if necessary, prior to being taken into the custody at FCI Coleman.
6. This motion is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, for the reason set forth herein, Defendant Sotis respectfully requests that the Court grant the forgoing motion and extend his self-surrender date for a period of sixty days,

or at such time thereafter convenient to the Court, and for all other and further relief deemed just and proper under the circumstances.
