Dick Long is one of the pioneers of the diving industry and the founder of Diving Unlimited International. In 1965 he worked as a contract diver for the U.S. Navy in the Arctic and from 1965 through 1972 he operated his own commercial diving company. He is former Chairman of the San Diego Oceans Foundation. His consuming passion during the last few years has been the management of the sinking of the *Yukon*, a former Canadian Navy ship, which has become an artificial reef for divers. Currently, Dick is the Chief Advisor to the Board of Directors of California Ships to Reefs, and Chairman of its Phase 2 Committee, charged with getting ships on the bottom within two years.
