**ORDER DENYING AS MOOT TRUSTEE'S MOTION FOR TURNOVER
OF FUNDS HELD AS A RESULT OF STATE COURT LITIGATION**

This matter came before the Court for hearing on April 30, 2020 ("Hearing"), upon the (i) Trustee's Motion for Turnover of Funds Held as a Result of State Court Litigation [ECF #35] (the "Motion") and (ii) Objection by Creditor, Shawn Robotka, To The Trustee's Motion For Turnover Of Funds Held as a Result of State Court Litigation filed by Creditor, Shawn Robotka [ECF #40] (the "Objection"). During the Hearing the Court heard from the respective counsel for the Trustee and Robotka concerning a proposed settlement of all issues between them which would include a resolution of the issues raised by the Motion and Objection. That proposed settlement has now

been submitted to the Court for approval by motion of the Trustee [ECF #50] (“Settlement Motion”), with a hearing on the Settlement Motion scheduled for May 21, 2020 [ECF #51]. The Court also heard from counsel for the law firm of Keller Landsberg, P.A., which pursuant to a prior state court order is currently holding in its trust account the funds at issue in the Motion and Opposition (the “Disputed Funds”). For the reasons stated upon the record in open Court, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Trustee’s Motion for Turnover of Funds Held as a Result of State Court Litigation is DENIED AS MOOT, without prejudice.
2. Keller Landsberg, P.A. is authorized to hold the Disputed Funds in its trust account pending further order of this Court.
