
ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO TRAVEL

This matter is before the Court on the unopposed Motion for Permission to travel filed by counsel for Peter Sotis (DE68) and the unopposed Motion for Temporary Return of Passport (DE69). The Court having reviewed the Motions, being advised that the Government and the United States Probation office have no objection to either requested relief, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED that both the Motion to Travel and the Motion for Temporary Return of Passport are hereby GRANTED. The Defendant Peter Sotis is granted permission to travel from Delray Beach, Florida to Cancun, Mexico on July1, 2021 through July 6, 2021. Defendant will reside during this period at his condominium quetzal G-H3, 77780, Quinyana Roo Mexico which is approximately one half hour south from Cancun. The U.S. Probation office shall provide the Defendant with his U.S. passport. Defendant shall provide the Pretrial Services Officer with a detailed itinerary and alternate phone numbers while in Mexico. The Defendant is also instructed to contact and return his U.S. passport to his Pretrial Services Officer immediately upon

his return to the United States.
