ORDER ON UNITED STATES' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE TRIAL

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on *United States' Unopposed Motion to Continue Trial* [DE 72] this Court having considered same, and being fully advised in the premises, it is hereby:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that said motion be hereby GRANTED; the Court finds, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A), that, based on the representations of the Government that a critical witness has an immovable scheduling conflict in September 2021, the ends of justice served by this continuance outweigh the demands of the Speedy Trial Act.

Accordingly, the period of delay resulting from this continuance—from the date of this Order, through the start of trial—shall be considered excludable time under the Speedy Trial Act. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 3161. The trial for defendants Peter Sotis and Emilie Voissem shall be re-set for \_\_\_\_, 2021.
