## Channel Islands Checklist

Gear (bring one bag for the deck):

- Mask and Fins (good idea to label)
- Booties and Gloves
- Hood
- Wetsuit
- Wetsuit hanger
- Weight belt
- 1 Tank
- Regulator and Computer
- Buoyancy Compensator
- Flashlight
- Beacon/light sticks

Things you might forget:

- Sleeping bag (pillow/blanket provided, I bring a pillow case and sheet)
- Clock/watch with light
- Water bottle (refill and keep in bunk)
- 2 Towels (Beach and Shower)
- Toiletries bag (to bring into shared bathroom)
- Sunscreen, hat, sunglasses
- Beer and wine
- Windbreaker, warm jacket, hat, Uggs, hot water bottle...
- Certification card
- Flip-flops
- Cash for Crew tip

Just in case:

- Mask strap
- Fin strap
- Batteries (computer, camera, flashlight)
- O-rings
- \*Seasickness medicine (generic: meclizine)
- \*Sudafed (generic: sudafedrine hydrochloride)
- \*Swimmer's Ear

\*try medications prior to diving

**Call the Sea Landing to reserve gear: 805-962-1127**

**Directions, coming from the North:**

Head South down Hwy 101 take the Castillo Street exit in Santa Barbara.

Take a right on Castillo, go to Cabrillo and take a right.

Go to Harbor Way and take a left, (this is the main harbor entrance.)

Take a left at the Naval Reserve Building, and pass into the parking lot after taking a parking ticket. Go straight to the last parking lot, you will see the Sea Landing Building and the Boats sitting at the dock.

If you parked in a double length stall (reserved for vehicles with boat trailers) you will be ticketed and towed. Validate your parking ticket at the Sea Landing; parking costs three dollars a day.



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
