The DAN Instructor Qualification Course (IQC) is the pathway to becoming a DAN Instructor. Active diving professionals who are DAN Members are eligible to enroll in this program. A CPR Instructor credential is also required but can be obtained as part of the IQC.

Most instructor candidates begin with the Diving Emergency Management Provider (DEMP) program, which instructs candidates how to teach the four component courses of the program. It also covers how to teach the courses as the comprehensive DEMP program.

Upon completion you will be able to conduct the BLS CPR and First Aid course, Neurological Assessment, Oxygen First Aid for SCUBA Diving Injuries and First Aid for Hazardous Marine Life Injuries.

Prerequisites for this course are:

- Be a certified and active SCUBA Diving educator (Divemaster or above)
- Be a current DAN Member
- Complete the DAN Online Core Module prior to attendance
- Complete the 4 course online training modules prior to attendance
- Current Provider as a DAN DEMP Provider is preferred
