



Two “Dive Against Debris” Dive Cleanups – September 21st and Sept 28th, 2013

Tampa Bay Green Consortium is sponsoring two separate Dive Against Debris events this year to support International Coastal Cleanup 2013

Volunteers needed for these events include:

- **Divers** - All divers must be Open Water certified with at least 30 open water dives in their logbook. On the day of the dive cleanup, dive volunteers must submit their signed liability form (will send separately with Dive Plan). Diver/surface marker buoys are required for this dive event.
- **Kayaks/canoes** – Volunteers with kayaks or paddleboards will support the divers in the water.
- **Safety observers** – Need pier and shore safety observers. Shore safety observers will assist divers in and out of the water.
- **Data collectors** - Document debris collected for submission to Ocean Conservancy's Marine Debris Index.
