



Traveling with your DeWalt Batteries

The information provided is based on the experiences of numerous travelers who have successfully brought their DPVs and batteries on many flights with various airlines and through different countries. It has been observed that airports and countries with stricter regulations have shown more consistency with 9AH Dewalt batteries, as opposed to the 12AH ones. Therefore, when traveling to remote locations, it may be advisable to opt for the 9AH

Ensure that these batteries are kept in your carry-on luggage, not in checked bags or equipment. Remember to follow these guidelines.



Travel with discharged batteries

For a more successful travel experience with these batteries, we recommend discharging them before your flight. This practice has contributed to the success of numerous travelers using larger capacity batteries and ensuring smooth passages through security checks.



For a more successful trip through TSA this is what we suggest.

For every Two discharged batteries with DeWalt Red Air Travel Clip Installed, you will need x1 large clean clear Ziploc Bag and x1 printed copy of the DeWalt MSDS (Safety Date Sheet) in the appropriate language.

The Battery MSDS sheet can be found for printing by a simple google search of "DeWalt MSDS" .

Additionally having things like TSA precheck have also helped users with moving through airport security.
