FastFind PLB Dive Canister

Owners Manual

Introduction

This Dive Canister allows the McMurdo FastFind products to be used by Sports and Commercial divers the world over for safer diving. In case of an emergency, the FastFind will alert the Search and Rescue Services.

Please read these instructions carefully and keep them in a safe place for future reference.

Dive canister


The FastFind Dive Canister is designed with dual seals to prevent water ingress into the threads and to provide double reliability to protect the FastFind.

Open the canister by turning the twist cap anti-clockwise. When replacing the cap, take care to avoid cross-threading. To fit the cap to the body, first turn the cap anti-clockwise (to locate the thread), then tighten the cap clockwise against the flange. Hand-tight is sufficient to form a watertight seal.


Fixing

To attach the Dive Canister to your STAB or BCD, simply thread the 50mm (2") webbing or a belt through the webbing slot, as shown.

Note: An attachment hole is provided in the lid. This allows the lid to be retained, using a tie, to prevent its loss when the canister is open.



For non-slip fitting, add a Bar Buckle as shown below.



Maintenance

After use, the Dive Canister should be rinsed with fresh water. Periodically check and remove any build-up of salt crystals around the O-rings and lightly lubricate the ring with a silicone grease.

Size	162mm high x 94mm diameter
Weight empty	900g
Material yellow	HE30 aluminium, anodised
'O' rings	78mm id x 3mm wide 82mm id x 2mm wide
Depth rating	150m

NOTE: This canister will only house the standard Fastfind and Fastfind Plus PLBs, and will not accommodate the larger Class 1 (-40°C) battery pack.
