On 15th April a group of volunteers including many Bedouin children from Assalah managed to clean about 1 km of beach, starting from the Eel Garden SSDM Shade until the last houses

on Assalah Beach. The event was organised by new VR trainee Jose Hoeflaken. During the day 90 camel bags were filled with rubbish. Large items like car tyres were collected separately. We received donations of rubbish bags, work gloves and a vehicle during the day. All the rubbish was collected and recycled by Hemaya.



To thank everyone for their efforts a BBQ was held that evening for all the volunteers. Food and drinks were generously donated by a number of bars and restaurants. Volunteer Rangers and the National Parks thank all those who took part and helped us to protect the living reef and to make Dahab a cleaner place to live.
